Mai i te oro o ngā mea katoa ka tipu ko ngā oro o te reo Māori, me te tangi, te kū rānei o ngā kupu o te reo Māori.

Ko te pū o te oro i ahu mai i ngā oro o te taiao, arā, mai i te rangi ko te tētere me ngā hau. Mai raro i te whenua o ngā ngunguru o Rūaumoko, o Hinetaukepeka, o Pūpū me Hoata. Kai te wao, ko ngā rārā o ngā rau rākau me te kō o ngā manu me te kekē o ngā ngārara. Kai t e moana, ko ngā tangi o ngā tai. I roto i ngā mahi a te tangata ka puta ko īona momo oro, ko īona momo rangi, ko īona mita. Inā i roto i ngā mahi taonga hoki a te tangata, ka puta ko ngā momo oro o te paopao o te toki, o te kuoro o te kohatu ukuikui, te rarā o te ruirui o te piupiu me wērā atu.

Kai roto i ngā kupu me ngā momo kōrero, waiata, haka me ngā karakia a te Māori ngā oro o te taiao. Ko ngā oro nei hai tūhono i te ao tangata ki te ao o te wao. Ko ngā momo oro hai tūhono i te ao kikokiko ki te ao wairua, te ira tangata ki te ira atua.

Hai tauira ake i wēnei rārangi kōrero i runga nei ka whai ake au i ngā tauira whakamārama o tētahi pure karakia i whakamahia e tōku tipuna e Ngakuru Raerino Patupo. Ki ngā kōrero i whānau mai a ia i te tau 1869 ka ma te i te tau

1943. Koia he tohunga ki te tā moko. Nō ngā kāwai o Tūhoe, Ngāti Awa me Te Arawa. Ōna hapū ko Te Warahoe, Ngāmaihi, Ngāti Nuku me Pahipoto o Mataatua, ko Ngāti Tarawhai ki a Te Arawa. Nāna te kauhau tuatahi a te Ringatū ki roto i te Paremata. He tohunga a ia ki ngā karakia tawhito a te Māori me ngā karakia hoki a te hāhi Ringatū. He tohunga ki ngā waiata mōteatea ki ngā haka hoki.

Nā reira kapi katoa i a ia te whānuitanga o ngā mahi Maori. Ko ia tētahi o ngā rangatira kai roto i te whakaahua e iri ana i roto o “Te Whai o Te Motu” i Ruatāhuna. Āna tama a Tioke rāua ko Tioti Te Raame Raerino he pāpā ki tōku matua, ki a Ngamaru Raerino. Nā toku matua nā Ngamaru i homai wēnei kōrero ki a ahau.

tika ana, kia tīmata ake wēnei rārangi kōrero whakamāramatanga ki tētahi karakia. Ko tēnei karakia he wāhangā o te pure. Tōna mahi tō te pure, he whakaū, he whakahuihui i ngā mahi me ngā whakaaro o ngā tāngata ki te Atua. Ko ia nei ngā mahi a tinana, hai whakapūmau i ngā tikanga e whakaritea ana e ngā tāngata i waenga i ā rātau me te Atua, otirā i a ia me ū rātau Atua rānei. Ko te pure hai horoi hoki kia mā, kia māhaki te tinana, te ngākau, te wairua o te ira tangata, kia urutapu ai tōna tū ki mua ki te aroaro o ngā Atua. E kore i tua atu i tēnei. Ma tēnei e whakamau te tapu, e tango rānei taua tapu, kia wātea ai te neke o ngā mahi-a-tangata.

I whakamaua ake tēnei o ngā pure hai whakaatu i te hononga o te ao kikokiko ki te ao wairua, te reo hoki me ngā atua. Arā, menā he reo tō te Atua, he reo anō tō te tangata, he reo anō pea hoki tō te mauri, te hau rānei. Inā hoki ngā kōrero me ngā whakamārama mai i ngā tīpuna Māori o nehe e kii ana kai roto i ngā pure me ngā karakia e oke ana te katoa o ngā tikanga a te Māori. Tērā hoki te kōrero a Te Rāme Raerino;

Me ka rapu haere ana te tangata i te whānuitanga o ngā mea Māori kaua a ia e tū tawhiti mai te tirotiro ki wēnei tokorua, te pure me te karakia. Kai ā rāua e oke ana te tino mauri me te hau o ngā tikanga a te Māori. Te mauri me tōnā whakaihihi i ngā mea katoa. Te hau hai whāngai i te hā me te hī ki roto ki te tangata me te whenua.²

Ko tētahi mea nui hai whakamārama ake mō tēnei, te kawe i tēnei pure, me wērā atu momo karakia ko te whakahua ūteretere i ngā kupu. Inā te rite o te reo o te kaiwhakahua ki te oro heke o te horowai. He horohoro te mita o te whakahua. Ka rite tonu te oro o te reo ki te wai koropupū.

Mai i te rārangi tuatahi ka rite tonu te whakahua o ngā kupu ki te māturuturu o te wai mai i te rau rui wai a te tohunga i te wā e ruku ana, e pure ana ia i te

tangata i roto i te wai. Inā ngā kupu kai te hoki ki te takeatanga mai o te tangata, o te kawa, o te tapu, mai Hawaiki tae noa atu ki te wā e hono tonu ana a Papatuanuku ki a Ranginui.

Kai roto i tēnei pure ko ngā kupu whakaata i ngā oro o te taiao. Ko te pōhutu, ko te taka o tētahi mea nui ki roto o te wai. Heoi, ko te oro tēnei o te whati o te ngaru nui ki te takutai. Inā kai te rangi te reo pāoro o Rangi, ko te tētere tērā. He tohu katoa wēnei kua tuku mai ngā Atua i a rātau tohu ki te hunga e tuku kupu ana ki a rātau. Ko ngā ‘cape tī, cape tā, cape tau’, ko te mao o te ua, o te marangai, inā kua māhea ngā mea katoa hai mahi mā te tangata, kua purea, kua eke.

Kai whea hoiki te tīmata mai o tātau o te Māori i tua atu i a Hawaiki e mohiotia nei i roto i ngā kōrero tahito. Tēnā ia tātau e huri ki ngā kōrero ka kitea i ahu ake tātau mai i te one nā Tane i whakapukepuke. Ka huaina ko Hineahuone te kuia nei. E kore hoki e warewaretia ngā whakapapa hoki rawa ki te Kore, te Pō ki a Ranginui rāua ko tōna wahine ki a Papatuanuku


Nō reira he tirotiro tēnei i te tīmatatanga mai o te Māori e mohiotia nei e tātau me te hamumutanga o te reo o te tangi otirā o te kupu. Menā ka takinatia mai ngā kawai me tīmata mai rā i te tīmatatanga arā ‘i tua i tawhiti i Hawaiki’. Mai i a Rangi rāua ko Papa otirā i a rātau ngā Ariki me te ira Atua. Otirā ka whakatākahia mai te heke kawai i a rātau mā, tau rawa iho ki a tātau te ira tangata e takatū nei i te mata o te whenua.

Ina rā tēnei o ngā whakatauki, “Ko te amorangi ki mua, ko te hāpai ō ki muri”. Te amorangi te whakahua ake o te kupu nei arā he amo mā te waha tonu o te tangata e taea ai te kapoka po hau. Koinei anō hoki te mahi a tēnei kupu he

hao, he kapo, he kohikohi, nā reira menā te kaikōrero e whakamahi ana i tēnei kupu, kua tīmata a ia ki te ngote hau hai puha i te kupu nei. Nā reira, hai huringa ake anō, arā te amorangi, e whai noa atu i ngā mahi -a-ringa, arā ko te hapai ū. He whakapūareare anō tēnei i te māngai ki a tika anō te tangi mai o te kupu. Taua kupu rā hoki he whakaramemene i ngā mea katoa kia uru katoa atu. Koira anō te tangi mai o te kupu.

He maha ngā whakamārama mō te pū o te oro, me te oro o te reo. Heoi, kia tahuri ake ki wētahi tirohanga ki te oro, ki te kū o te kupu . Hai tīmatanga ake me aro te titiro ki te kupu nei te ‘kupu’. I roto i ngā kōrerotanga ki a Hirini Melbourne³ ki a ia, ko te kū, he oro tērā, arā, ko te kū o te kupu, ko te oro o tērā kupu. Ko te ‘pu’, ko tōna tīmatatanga, tōna pupū ake, me kī pēnei, te takenga o te kupu. Nā, ka moe a kū i a pū ka puta ko te ‘Kupu’, tirohia te whika 1 e whai ake nei.


Sound Symbolism : Sound symbolism is said to be present when a speech sound seems to correlate with an object in the real world. The correlation may take the form of 'onomatopoeia' or 'mimesis,' where a sound originating from an animate or inanimate source is reproduced more or less accurately by the human articulatory organs as a lexical item. It may take the form of synesthesia or gesture as well.⁴

Waihoki, ka hāpai te pū i ngā waiata, engari a tōna wā nā te mahi a te waiata, karakia rānei, ka rerekē te pū. I te mea, inā ka rangona te waiata e te iwi, ā, ka puta he whakamārama hou mō tērā kupu. Pēnā, i ngā kōrero a Papesch⁵, i tōna titotanga i tētahi o āna waiata, i whakaurua te kupu ‘matū’, nā, he whakamārama tāna ake mō te kupu, nā ngā mahi pēnei ka ahu mai he whakamārama hou mō taua kupu.

I tēnei upoko kua tirohia e tātau he aha te tikanga o te kū o te kupu. Kua whakamāramahia, kua whakawhāitihiia te tirohanga ki te kaupapa nei. Kua puta hoki ngā take e whāia ana e te rangahau nei.

E whai ake nei tētahi whakataukī i takinatia e te kaumātua nei e Te Irirangi Tahuriorangi Tiakiawa o Ngāti Pikao. Otirā nō ngā karangarangatanga maha ia o te waka nei o Te Arawa. Koia nei tētahi o ngā tohunga o ngā karakia tawhito me ngā kōrero o nehe rawa. Te nuinga o āna kōrero i puta mai i te rahi o Te Arawa, i mau wēnei o āna kōrero i tōku pāpā i a Ngamaru Raerino i te wā e mahi tahi ana rāua i te Tari Māori ki Rotorua.

Inā te rite o te oro o tēnei ki te tangi a te pipi manu ki ūna tauheke hai whāngai i a ia ki te kai. Inā ko te whakamārama, ki te whiwhi te tamaiti i te mātaurang a me whakarite ia ki te paihau turuki, arā, ki te pīpī e pati ana kia whāngaihia ia e tōna tauheke. Kōnei te rite o ngā tamariki i wēnei wā. Ānei e whai ake nei;

TE UPOKO TUARUA

Ko te mahi o tēnei upoko he āta tirotiro i ngā kōrero kua tuhia mō te kū o te kupu e ngā kairangahau wherawhera i te reo. Kai konei ka whakatakoto ngā pūtake mō te rangahau nei. Ko wēnei he whakarāpopoto i ā rātau kōrero. Ko tāku he whāriki, he whakaemi, ko wēhea ki tāku titiro he pai hai whai ki te whakawhānui i te kaupapa o te kū o te kupu.

Ko ngā Kohinga Kōrero

Tokoiti noa iho ngā kairangahau reo kua uru ki ngā wherawherahanga i tēnei kaupapa te kū o te kupu. Otirā ia, kāore hoki tēnei kaupapa i whāia whānuitia i roto anō i wērā reo huri noa i te ao. Nō reira, ka takahi ake te kaituhi i ngā tapuwae o te mātātahi i roto nei rā i te tupārae kopikopiko o te reo. Arā noa atu ngā pikinga taumata hai kake māna kia tae atu ki te pū o te pātaka mātauranga o ngā kopikopiko o te reo e kawea nei.

Nā runga o tēnā āhuatanga e kore e nui ana ngā rauemi tuhinga kōrero e pā ana ki tēnei kaupapa i roto i te reo Māori. Kaore ngā mātāpuna matua o te tuhinga o te reo Māori arā, a Smyth⁷, a Harawira⁸, a Biggs⁹, a Waititi¹⁰, a Moorfield¹¹, me wētahi atu kairangahau i whakaputa kōrero nui mō tēnei kaupapa. Engari kotahi anake te kaituhituhi kua aro mai ki tēnei taha arā ki te kū o te kupu i roto i te reo Māori, arā ko Bauer¹². Heoi, he wāhangā paku nei i tirohia e ia,

arā i tētahi uri o te kū o te kupu. Engari i huri kē te nuinga o rātau ki te aro atu ki te takotoranga kupu me te whai hua o te hangaitanga kē o te kupu.

Nā reira me tahuri ake tātau ki ngā kaituhi Pākehā i wherawhera i te ‘kū o te kupu’. Me tīmata i te tohunga kiriki nei ki a Plato, nāna nei i tīmata te tūhono o te pū o tētahi kupu me tōna kū. I 395 BC pea te kōrerotanga a Plato, ka whakarite e ia ngā mahi a te kaihanga ture reo ki ngā ingoa o ngā mea katoa. Ko tana pātai, he hononga pātahi kai waenga te āhua o tētahi mea me tōna ingoa kua tapaina. Heoi anō, kai roto i āna kōrerotanga ka puta wētahi whakaaro pai. Pēnei i te kōrero, “*orthoteta tina ton onomatopehukenai*,”¹³ arā, he ingoa tūturu tō ngā mea katoa, ka ahu mai i te taiao. Ka tautoko a Lucretius i tēnei ki tāna kōrero;

*putare aliquem tum nomina distribuisse desiperest. Nam cur hic posset cuncta notare vocibus et varios sonitus emittere linguae tempore eodem alii id non quisse putentur. That is, that people who think that some individual could, by himself, have invented words arbitrarily are talking nonsense*¹⁴.

Arā, e kore rawa e hanga kupu mā te kapokapo noa.

E kii ana e rua ngā roopū whakaaro, e ai ki tā Collins¹⁵ kai tētahi taha ko ngā tangata e whakapono ana i te “*Juliet*” whakaarohanga, ā, kai tētahi taha ko te “*Joyce*” whakaarohanga. Ka ahu mai te “*Juliet*” whakaarohanga mai i te waituhi “*Romeo and Juliet*” nā Shakespeare me te raina kōrero, “*That which*

*we call a rose, by any other name would smell as sweet*¹⁶. Arā, karekau he tūhonotanga kai waenganui i te ingoa o tētahi mea me tōna whakamārama.

Engari anō ngā tāngata e whakapono ana i te “Joyce” whakaarohangā, ka ahu mai tēnei whakaarohangā i te kaituhi a James Joyce nō Airihi. I roto i āna waituhinga, i hangaia e ia te maha o ngā kupu hou, ōrite te tangi ki te whakamārama.

Heoi anō, kua heke iho te pātai, arā, “he hononga pātahi kai waenga i te kū me te pū” i waenga i ngā kairangahau reo Pākehā. Engari, i te tīmatatanga o tērā rautau (20th) i āta tīmataria te mahi rangahau reo, arā, mahi ringikuihi. I tōna wā, ko te tangata kai a ia te mahi o te kōrero ko Otto Jespersen me tana pukapuka ‘*Language; Its nature, development and origin*’¹⁷. Kotahi te upoko kai roto i te pukapuka nei e kōrero pū ana mō te kū te kupu. Nō Denmark te tangata nei i mahi ai ia ki te Whare Wānanga o Copenhagen, he tangata nāna i para te huarahi mō te mahi ringikuihi.

Kai roto i tana pukapuka, he maha ngā kōrero mō ngā tūmomo whakaaroaro e pā ana ki te pātai, ‘i ahu mai te reo i hea?’ He kupu whakatupato nāna, ka kī a ia, ko te kōrero mai o te Hunga Ringikuihi o Wiwi, kaua rā e whai i te kaupapa ‘te takenga o te reo’ ka anini noa iho te mahunga, kaorekau he hua ka puta. He whakaaro i hurihuri i roto i te hinengaro o te kaira ngahau e a ia e tuhi nei i wētahi upoko o te tuhingaroa nei, heoi.

Ka tīmata te kōrero ki te whakaaro he mea e ora ana te reo. Ka tautoko a Jespersen i te kōrero, nui ake te wariu o te reo-a-waha ki te reo-a-tuhi, ka

kōrero ia mō te reo Rātini¹⁸, i ngā tau ki muri ka tino whai ngā tangata i te reo tuhituhi o tēnei reo, ā, tae atu ki te 16th rautau, tē aro i ngā kaikōrero o Rātini nō Ingarangi i te reo-a-waha o ngā kaikōrero Rātini nō Wiwi, ahakoa i te kōrero i te reo kotahi rātau katoa, na te whakahua/mita rānei i raru ai. Ka kōrero hoki ia, “*There are still too many writers on philological questions who have evidently never tried to think in sounds instead of thinking in letters and symbols...*”¹⁹. Ka tautoko tēnei kōrero i tāku e whai nei, nā te mea, ko tētahi whainga o te rangahau nei, kia aro te titiro o ngā kairangahau reo Māori ki ngā tangi o te reo Māori.

I te mea, he maha ngā tangata kua kōrerohia e Jespersen, kai te pirangi te kaituhi nei ki te whai atu i āna tuhinga, me te wherawhera i tēnei, hai whakapiki ake i te māramatanga o ngā kaipānui nei.

Ko te take e tino pātahia ana ko te tīmatatanga o te reo ki te kū o te kupu, ki wētahi whakaaro, kai roto i te kū te tīmatatanga o te reo. He maha hoki ngā tangata Pākehā kua whakaaro i tēnei pātai “nō hea te reo tangata?” Ko tāku kōrero mō tēnei kaupapa, kai roto i te upoko tuatoru, he whakamārama nā wētahi pū kōrero Māori.

E ai ki a Herder²⁰ i te wā tuatahi i kite te tangata i tētahi mea ka rongo ki tana tangi ka tapaina he ingoa. Hai whakatauira, ka kitea he hipi, ka ‘bleat’ te hipi rā, ā, ka whakaaro te tangata he ‘bleater’ tērā kararehe, nō reira e ai ki tēnei whakaaroaro ka tipu mai ngā tu-ingoa mai i ngā tu-mahi. He whakaaro pai tēnei ki te kaituhi nei, i te mea ka kite i wētahi āhuatanga pēnei ana i te reo Māori, ā, i roto hoki i tāku nei rangahau, pēnā i te Kākā, Tītī, arā;

Ka kōrero a Friedrich von Schlegel²² mō te reo ‘*Manchu*’ nō Haina, he tino piringa tahi kai waenga i tērā reo me ngā kupu orōmahara, otirā, ki ūna whakaaro kaore e kore, ko tēnei pupūhangā he tino poutoko i te hangahanga o te reo o ‘*Manchu*’. Engari, ehara i te mea ka pēnei te katoa o ngā reo, pērā i te reo ‘*Sanskirt*’, pakupaku noa iho ngā pupūhangā o ngā kupu orōmahara. Ahakoa tēnei ki ngā whakaaro o te kaituhi o tēnei tuhingaroa, ko te piringa kai waenga i te reo me ngā kupu orōmahara, he kaupapa matua hoki mō te reo Māori.

Ka kōrero a Jespersen mō te mahi hanga kupu ororite ā te tamariki mō ngā mea hou e kitea ana e rātau²³. Hai whakatauira i tēnei i hanga tētahi tama mai i Tiamani i te kupu ‘*gingging*’ mō te karaka, i tapaina ingoa e tētahi kōtiro ki te “*vakvak*” mō te kokako, he kupu ororite. Tērā pea, ka tautoko tēnei i tā Herder kōrero mō te ‘*bleater*’.

Ka kōrero a Jespersen mō te pānga o ngā āhuatanga o te ngākau ki te reo. E ai ki a ia, ka rerekē te reo menā e riri ana te kaikōrero²⁴, hai whakakaha i tēnei ka kōrero ia mō te reo o ngā ope tauā, he rerekē te mita me te whakahua o wēnei ki te kōrero noa o te tangata. Whai muri i tēnei, nā te āhua o te kanohi ka rerekē te whakahua o ngā kupu. I te mea ki te menemene te kaikōrero kua

whātoro te waha, ki te pouri te kanohi kua kotē te waha, ā, ka rerekē te reo²⁵. I te reo Ingarihi ka takahuri te oro ‘y’ hai ‘i’ nā te kanohi harikoa. Ko te rongoreka (*euphony*)²⁶ he tino mahi o te tangata e a ia e kōrero ana, koinei te tino whakapono o ngā kairangahau o tērā rautau ki muri. Ka kōrerohia ake tēnei i te upoko tuarima. I te mea, hangai tonu tēnei ki tāku e kimi nei, e whakamārama nei.

He whakapae tō Jerspersen, kai runga rawa atu ngā reo e whakamahi ana i te iti o ngā kupu engari he nui te whakamārama kai muri;

That Language ranks highest which goes farthest in the art of accomplishing much with little means, or, in other words, which is able to express the greatest amount of meaning with the simplest mechanism.²⁷

Kai te whakaae hoki ahau ki tēnei, tērā pea, nā te hapai o ngā kū, ka tere mōhio te tangata i te pū o te kupu. Āna, ka hono tērā ki taku nei rangahau.

Ka wehewehe a Jerspersen i ngā tūmomo kupu-oro. Tuatahi ko ngā kupu ororite (*imitation*) arā, ‘clink clank’ i te reo Pākehā. Tuarua ko ngā kupu orowawaru (echo) pēnei i te *cuckoo*, ko te ingoa o te kararehe e whakakā ana i tērā tangi, ‘peeweeet, ‘cuckoo’. Ka kuhu mai i wēnei ko ngā ingoa mō ngā iwi e kaha ana ki te whakamahi i tētahi kupu, pēnei i te iwi o Wiwi, i te mea, e kaha ana tērā iwi ki te whakamahi i te kupu ‘oui’, ā, kua tapaina rātau ki tērā ingoa, arā Wiwi. Kai kōrā hoki wētahi atu ingoa nō tāwāhi, ko te ingoa mō ngā kaumōana Amerikana i Hapanihi ko ‘*Damurāisu H’to*’ mai i te kaha o rātau ngā kaumōana ki te whakahua i te kīwaha ‘*Damn your eyes*²⁸’ me te kupu *H’tō*, te kupu hapanihi mō tāngata. I ngā tau ki muri ka karangahia ngā

Ingarihi e ngā Wīwī ki te ingoa ‘godon’ mai i te kīwaha ‘god damn’, kai roto i Haina ka karangahia ngā Ingarihi ki te ingoa ‘a -says’ mai i te ‘I says’.

Tuatoru, i te mea nā te nekenekehanga o tētahi mea ka puta he tangi/oro/oru rānei, nā, ka rongo te tāringa i tēnei nekenekehanga, e tika ana kia whai tōtika ai tētahi kupu mō tērā nekehanga, pērā i ngā tūmahi pupū, puhotu, ngaehe o te wao nui a Tāne. Ka whai hoki ko ngā mahinga tāngata pēnei i te pātōtō, pakipaki. Mai i wēnei ka whakawhiti ngā tūmahi hai tū ingoa, arā, ‘*hack*’ te tūmahi topatopa ki te tūingoa ‘*hack*’ he tūmomo toki i te reo Pākehā. Tērā pea ko te kupu Māori mō te ‘Sparrow’ kua whaia i tēnei tauira, ka tiu te manu, ā, kua tapaina ki te ingoa Tiu

Kai reira hoki ngā kupu nekenekēhangā mō ngā nekenekehanga kore i te tino kaha te rongo o te tāringa. Kai roto i te reo Pākehā ko ngā kupu e tūhono ana ki te reta “*l*” pēnei i te ‘*fl*’ arā, ‘*flow*’, ‘*flag*’, ‘*flicker*’ kai korā hoki te ‘*sl*’ arā, ‘*slide*’, ‘*slip*’ me ngā tūmomo kupu e whakaatu ana i te mahi o tētah i mea, engari mā ngā karu kē e ‘*rongo*’ arā ‘*totter*’, ‘*dodder*’.

Kai reira ngā momo kupu mō te nekenekehanga tere, he orokati poto me tētahi oropuare (mō te reo Pākehā tēnei) pēnei i te ‘*pat*’, engari pea, ka pēnei hoki te reo Māori, kai korā te kupu ‘*paki*’, ‘*pato*’.

Kua kiia he tūhonotanga kai waenga i te āhua o tētahi mea me tana rongo. He tūhonotanga hoki kai waenga i ngā oro teitei me te ao (*light*), waihoki ngā oro taketake me te pō (*darkness*) arā te Tēpu 1, nō reira, ki tēnei whakaarohanga pai ake te oropuare ‘i’ me te ‘a’ mō te ao, ko te oropuare ‘u’ me te ‘o’ mō te pō.

Kua kitea, he maha ngā āhuatanga i tuhia e Jespersen mō te kaupapa nei, hangai te nuinga ki tāku rangahau he maha ngā mea ka taea te whakawhiti ki te reo Māori.

I roto i te tuhituhinga a Firth²⁹ (tētahi tangata nō Ingarangi) kua puta wētahi whakaaro pai. He toiahurewa a Firth mō tētahi whare wānanga i Ingarangi. Ko ia te tuatahi i whiwhi i tētahi tūranga toiahurewa mō te wherawhera i te reo i roto i Ingarangi. Me kī he tangata tūturu mō tēnei tūmahi. I roto i āna

tuhinga ka puta ngā whakaaro mō te pātai o te upoko tuatoru, arā i ahu mai te reo i hea? E ai ki tāna, ko te ‘*bow-wow, cuckoo*’ whakaaroaro te whakaarohanga tuatahi, arā, ko ngā kupu tuatahi i puta he orite te tangi/oro ki ngā oro kore-nā-tangata i rere i runga i te hau. Pēnā i ngā tangi manu, ngā ngaehe o te rākau rānei.

Ko tētahi atu whakaaroaro i puta mai ko te ‘*pooh -pooh*’ whakaaro ko tēnei ka pūpū ake ngā kupu mā te kuhu mai o te āhuatanga ngā kau arā, nā te mamae, nā te harikoa, nā te pōuritanga rānei, pēnā i ngā kupu ‘aue’, ‘tauwī’ me ngā kupu ngongoro ‘*aah, ooh*’. Anō, kai roto i te reo Māori he tino kaupapa tēnei mō te reo Māori.

Ka kōrero a Firth mō te kairangahau a Max Muller³⁰ me tana whakaaro ‘*ding-dong*’, arā, ka tūhono te reo ki ngā oro o te wao (tērā pea, e hangai ana tēnei ki ngā whakaaro Māori, arā kai te haeretahi te tangi o tētahi mea me te ingoa o taua mea).

Arā anō te kōrero a Tā Richard Paget, ki a ia, he orite te mahi o te arero ki te mahi o te ringa e rotarota ana i te tohu ‘hai kōnei rā’. Ka puta i a Paget te pātai, ko tehea te mātāmua, ko te rotarota, ko te kōrero rānei? Arā, “*voice developed in the trees, gesture on the ground*”³¹. Engari hai te mutunga iho o ngā whakaaro nei ka kii a Firth he whāiti rawa wēnei tirohanga kia ki ake, i peneitia te kuhunga mai o ngā reo. Heoi anō, he tauira Māori e hangai ana ki tēnei, arā, kei roto i te waiata a Hirini Melbourne³², arā, “Tirairaka, wero taiaha, tei tei ti ti tei.” Å, ka kanikani te arero i roto i te waha, pērā i ngā nekenekehanga, i ngā nukunukuhangā o te manu nei.

Ka kōrero hoki a Firth, kore e taea te hono te rongo-a -tāringa ki te kupu tuhituhi³³. Ka kōrero a ia mō ngā tāngata e ako ana i tētahi reo mai i ngā pukapuka, ko te raru o wēnei, e kore e akona ngā māmātanga o te reo, me kii te ‘economy’ o te reo, arā ngā kupu tumeke, ngā kōrero ngutungutu. Ka tika rawa atu te whakatakoto o te reo e kōrerohia atu rā e rātau, engari roa rawa ngā rerenga kōrero. Ka whakamahi ana i ngā kupu e tika ana mai i te papakupu, engari e hē ana ki ngā tāngata e kōrero ana i taua reo i a rā, i a rā³⁴.

E ai ki te pukapuka a Firth ki ngā kairangahau o Amerika, ko te “*onomatopoeia*” i takea mai ana i ngā nekenekehanga o te tinana, o te waha, o te karu, o te matimati, o te ngākau, ā, ka puta ko ngā kupu pērā i te ‘*gurgle, titter*’³⁵. Ka rongo-a-ngākau hoki ki wēnei kupu arā te kupu hanga pā (*kinaesthetic imagery*).

Nā reira he maha ngā hua o tēnei pukapuka, engari he tirohanga Pākehā tā Firth, te mea hoki, kaore i roto i te reo Māori ngā kōrero, kāore i aro atu ki te reo Māori hoki.

E kii ana wētahi o ngā kairangahau o Amerika, ko Sapir tētahi o ngā tino tangata tūturu mō te mahi ringikuihi, me kii he tangata tīmata o tērā rautau³⁶. I whānau mai a Sapir i te tau 1884 i Pomerania, Tiamani, engari, i haere a ia ki Amerika e rima tōna tau, i whakaako ia i te Whare Wānanga o Chicago, whai muri i Yale, i mate atu ia i te tau 1939 i puta tana pukapuka ‘Language’ i te tau

1921, e kii ana ngā kairingikuihi he pukapuka whakahirahira tēnei³⁷. Ka tautoko a Allot³⁸ i tēnei hoki, arā te kōrero o mua rā.

E ai ki ngā kōrero a Sapir ko ngā reo he huihuinga i ngā oro. Ka whakarārangihia e ia ngā whakaaro o te pūtake o ngā reo. Ka kōrero ia mō te “ooh” whakaaro, ā, paku noa iho tana tautoko i tēnei ka mea ake ia, “*These interjections are merely conventional fixations of the natural sounds*”³⁹. Engari ka mea atu hoki ia;

*In other words, the interjections and sound-imitative words of normal speech are related to their natural prototypes as is art, a purely social or cultural thing to nature*⁴⁰.

Ka kii ia, kaore i te tino hirahira ngā kupu tumeke nei (*interjections*). Kai reira hoki te ‘kupu ororite’ whakaaroaro arā, ka tipu te reo mai i ngā kupu ororite, engari ka whakahē hoki a Sapir i tēnei whakaaroaro. Kaore i te tino nui ngā hua i puta mai i tēnei pukapuka mō taku rangahau, engari kai reira tonu wētahi whakaaro pai, whakaaro hangai ki taku rangahau.

*Just as children were taught to imitate with their bodies the movements of branches, so they were taught to imitate with their voices winds, waves, and waterfalls. As a result, people listening to a chant could wonder whether they were hearing a human voice or the sounds of their environment*⁴¹.

Ko ngā kupu Pākehā o runga ake nei i tōia mai i te pepa a Charlot i runga anō rā i te taha kupu ororite mai rā i ngā whakaaro o te tangata whenua o ngā motu o Hawai’i, ahakoa anō rā ka pērā anō te āhua o ngā kōrero mā ngā Māori o

Aotearoa. Tēnei pepa nā Charlot he rapu whakamahinga o te kupu -ororite a te hunga tangata whenua o Hawai'i i a rātau e tapa ingoa ana mō ngā kararehe me te āhua o te reo tangi mai i wēnei kararehe. Hai tā Charlot he tino hangai tonu ana ngā kōrero ki tēnei rangahau nō te mea he wherawhera, he āta tirotiro koia tāna ki tētahi reo āhua pātata ki te nuinga o ngā nekenekehanga o te reo Māori o Aotearoa. Kotahi te raru o tēnei pepa he pāpaku noa te tirohanga. Kaore a Charlot i te homai tino tauira hai whakaatu i te kaupapa nei.

Kua whakaputaina e D. Salper⁴² h e pepa e tirotiro ana i te kaupapa kupu ororite, kupu hao tangi, kupu tā ahua⁴³ i tuhia i te reo Pākehā inā tirohia ana wēnei taha o te reo i roto i ngā waiata nā te Pākehā. Kai roto nei i wēnei tuhinga a Salper wētahi tauira ka taea te whakawhiti ki te reo Māori. Kai roto anō hoki i tēnei pepa te āta whakamāramatanga mō te āhua o te kupu hao tangi e kī nei hoki “*a definition of synesthesia and suggests that significance can be derived from vocal sound acting on the other senses through the sense of hearing*”⁴⁴. Ka haere tonu āna kōrero pēnei nā;

*The onomatopoeia theory holds vocal sound can suggest non-vocal sound. The gestural theory holds that motion and contour described by articulatory muscles can suggest motion and contour in the external world*⁴⁵.

Ka aro atu anō ia ki tētahi whakaaro e pa ana ki te kupu ororite;

*Elaborate sound-painting, the reproduction of natural sounds through speech-sounds in context where words, in themselves quite devoid of onomatopoeic effects, will be drawn into a sound pattern.*⁴⁶

He tino whainga o te kairangahau tēnei āhuatanga.

I āta aro matawaia e Baldon⁴⁷ te āhua o te kupu ororite i roto i ngā reo tokorima (Ingarihi, Tiamana, Wiwi, Tēkihi, Hapanihi). I roto o tēnei pepa ka āta tirohia te rerekētanga o ngā oropuare (vowel) e whakamahia ana i roto i tēnei te kupu ororite me ngā hua kōrero ka puta mai menā ka kōkiritia wēnei mahinga. Ki ngā whakaaro o tēnei kaituhi ko te raru kē e takoto mai ana pea i roto i te tikanga e puta ake ana te reo Māori i ngā whakaritenga-a-waha. Kai ngā kai-rangahau o mua i takea mai ā rātau hua rangahau i ngā tuhinga Māori. Otiia, kaore i aro atu ki ngā huihuitanga kupu a kōrero.

Inā ki a James Joyce ka taea te māramatanga o tētahi kupu i roto i te tangi, i te kū rānei o taua kupu. Ahakoa, ki tā Collins kāore tonu i taea katoatia te māramatanga o tētahi mea i roto i te kupu i tapaia taua mea. Inā te tauira, ka ōrite tonu te kakara o te rōhi, ahakoa ka tapaia ki tētahi ingoa atu.

Tuarua, ka kite iho tātau kāore e taea te kōrero i te kū o te kupu ki te kore e tirohia te pūtakenga mai o te reo.

Tuatoru, ko te reo he mea whakahuahua, kāore e takoto wahangū noa i roto i te pukapuka. Mā te whakahua ka rongohia ngā kū, ngā oro o te kupu, o te reo.

Tuawhā, kai tēnā reo, kei tēnā reo ōna oro, ōna kū, ōna tangi, ko te mea nui e ōrite tonu ana te hanga o ngā kupu ki roto i ngā reo. Menā ka tirohia ake ngā whakanikonikotanga o te reo me ūna tōpito, otirā ngā kokonga o tēnei kaupapa me pēnei te whakamārama. Tēnā ia ka hangatia he whare, hai whakaatu i ngā nohonga o wēnei whakanikonikotanga ka pēnei. Ki tētahi kokonga ko te whaikōrero, ki tētahi ko te waiata, ki tētahi ko te pakīwaitara/pūrākau ka mutu ake ai ki te kokonga tuawha ko te whakatauki (ngā momo whaiki). Ko te pure, te karakia te whatu o te kōrero o te reo, nā reira me tū ko ia ki waenganui ki te poutokomanawa rawa o te whare. Ko te poutokomanawa, hai pupuri nei i ngā torotorohanga, i ngā heke me te mauri o te reo.

Tēnei mea te pure, te karakia me ūna kawa, ūna takutaku, kore rawa i ngaro i tawhiti mai rānei i ngā mahi ā te Māori o nehe. I ngā wā o mua rā, he atua i runga, i raro, i roto, i waho, i ngā wāhi katoa e kitea ai te Māori. He mauri, he hau, he hā, i roto i te reo, i ngā kupu, i ngā kiingga, i ngā kōrero nā te Māori.

Ka taea e te kaikōrero te rau i te hunga e whakarongo ana ki āna kōrero, ka whakapaua tōna kaha ki te whakaorite i te hotu/taki o ū rāua manawa me te ngote hau kia rite anō hoki tā rāua kume hau te whāngai i ū rāua tinana. Ka tīmata mai te kaikōrero ki te karakia ka taea e te mita o tōna reo te tūhono mai i te whakaminenga kia riro rātau i te ia o tōna reo. Menā ka tika tana whakahuihui i ngā kupu kua pārekareka ki te whakarongo atu, anā hai reira kua tau te mauri kua tau anō hoki te wairua o te whakaminenga. Nā reira, ehara mā te kupu kotahi anake tēnei āhuatanga e whakatatū engari mā te kao me te tuku rere a te kaikōrero i āna kupu e taea ai te whakatatū i ngā mahara, te hinengaro, te tinana, te wairua me te mauri o te kaiwhakarongo. Koirā i tu kau ai te kaikōrero ki āna mahi, he ngeri, he karakia, he kawa tōna tīmatanga hai whakaratarata, hai whakatau i te hunga whakarongo.

Kua whakahuaina ngā whakanikonikotanga o te reo, āna, inaianei ka tahuri ki te whakatakoto i ngā whakaaro kōrero mō wēnei. Ko te nuinga o wēnei mōhiotanga i puta mai i te pukapuka ‘Ngā Mōteatea’⁵⁸. Nā, kua wehehia, kua taitarahia ngā wāhanga nei, nō reira, ka āta tirohia ngā momo tū waiata.

Popo/Oriori

Ka whānau tētahi tamaiti, he tamaiti rangatira nō ngā kāwai toa, ka titoa he whakaoriori e te whaea, e te matua, e ngā tīpuna rānei. Kai konā wētahi o ngā waiata nunui ā te Māori. Ka tikina te kaupapa ki Hawaiki rā anō tātai mai ai; ka tākina o reira mahi, o reira parekura; ā, ka tae ki te hekenga mai ki Aotearoa nei, ka puta o kōnei kāwai tangata, o kōnei parekura. Mehemea he parekura kai te takoto ki runga ki te kāwai o te tamaiti rā, ā, kaore anō ia, ka tohia ia ki te tohi o te toa, ka whakahuahuatia ūna piringa ki ngā rangatira toa e hau ana ngā rongo i te wā i titoa ai te waiata; ā, he mea anō ka whai te kaioraora, te kohukohu ki ngā tangata nāna te kohuru, te parekura rānei. Kai te houa e ngā tohunga o wēnei rā ngā waiata pēnei hai tautoko i ngā kōrero tīpuna onamata; kai te mohiotia hoki kai roto i ngā waiata ngā kōrero o ngā whare wānanga, ngā kōrero rānei a ngā tohunga o i a iwi i te wā i titoa ai aua waiata.

Ngā Waiata Whaiāipo.

Ko te nuinga o tēnā momo waiata kua ngaro; he rangi tahi wētahi, i mate tonu atu i te matenga o te hunga nāna i tito. Ko wētahi anō i mau, ā, e waiatatia nei i naianei. Kai konā ngā kupu whakaaroha o te reo Māori. Otira i whakauru mai anō wētahi āhua kupu, he kupu pai tonu i tō rātau nā wā, i te wā kai-tangata rā, i te wā kaore anō i tu ngā tikanga Pākehā hai aruaru i wērā hanga. Ngā Waiata-a-ringa

Kua whakapā te Māori o tēnei ao ki te nui o ngā mahi a te Pākehā, kua mahue haere ki rāhaki e ngā Māori o tēnei ao ngā mahi Māori o neherā, ngā mahi tahito hoki. Nā runiga o tēnei e rahi ngā Māori e kore kaha ki te hopu waiata, kōrero, i raro i ngā akoranga o neherā /namata.

Nā te rerekē o te taringa whakarongo o te Māori o tēnei ao ki ūna tipuna o mua, kua kore e tino taea e ngā Māori o tēnei reanga te hiki o wētahi kupu kōrero waiata tawhito. Koira, i āhua ngāwari ake te Māori o tēnei reanga ki te aru atu ki ngā waiata hou, arā, waiata-a-ringa. Koia ia pea i kaha kē te huri o ngā Māori o tēnei reanga ki te wāhi me te wetewete o te kupu tēnā ki te whakarongo ki te tohu ki te kū rānei o te kupu.

Tauparapara

Kua uru tēnei wāhanga i te mea, he mahia ngā āhuatanga o te tauparapara e pā tata ana ki tāku nā kaupapa e whai nei. Te tauparapara ka puaki tēnei i te tīmatanga o te whai kōrero tōna tikanga hoki he whakaatu atu ki te hunga e whakarongo mai ana nō whea te kaikōrero. Otirā te mahi kē mā te kaikōrero e huaki i ngā kupu kōrero hai whākī i ngā rārangī kōrero whakapapa, pepeha, nā te kaikōrero. Hai reira hoki te whakarongo a te hunga e rongo ana i ngā kōrero te taea te aru i ngā hikoikotanga me ngā pakiwaitara o te iwi i toia mai e te kaikōrero. Nā reira ngā kupu kōrero kai roto i te tauparapara, koinei te ingoa ki wētahi iwi, ki wētahi anō he pōhua kē te ingoa. Te nuinga o ngā tauparapara e ai ki ngā kōrero ā ōku nā kaumātua, ki a Te Wharehuia Milroy⁶⁰ hoki, he karakia kē te tauparapara, he momo pure. I mua i te tūnga o te kaikōrero ki te

whakahora i āna kōrero ka karakia nei a ia a puku, ko te tauparapara he karakia a waho. Mā tēnei hoki hai arataki, hai whakaihihi i te kaikōrero kia pākari kia hangai tonu ai āna kōrero ki runga k i te kaupapa o te rā. Nā reira tēnei te mahi a te tauparapara a te pōhua, he mau i te kaikōrero ki te kaupapa o te rā me te kore ai e tāpepe.

Ka hoki mai a ia ki te pūtake o tēnei tuhingaroa kia whānui, kia hohonu, kia matatau kē te tangata, otirā te kaikōrero ki ngā tangi ki ngā oro o te taiao kia taea ai e ia te huitahi ki ngā oro nā te tangata. Koinei kē te mea hai whakaaroaro mā te hunga e rawekeweke ana i ngā kupu, i ngā kōrero nā te Māori me tōna reo. Kia tapatahi te whakaaro, te pūmahara, te kori o te tinana me te tangi o te reo kia pārekareka mai te whakarongo otirā kia āhuru iho ngā whakaaro o te kaikōrero i a ia e tuku ana i āna kupu kōrero.

Ānei hoki te pātai, “pēhea te hapai o te reo i wēnei rā?” ‘Toi te kupu, toi te mana, toi te whenua’, i kiia e Tā Kingi Ihaka⁶¹ ko wēnei mea e toru te tino tuāpapa o te Māoritanga, ki te ngaro tētahi o wēnei, ka ngaro te Māoritanga. Ki te hoki tātau ki ngā 1970, i puta te awangawanga o te Iwi Māori, kai ngaro te reo Māori, i te purongo o Richard Benton⁶² i kiia e ia ki te kore e whakatika te āhuatanga o te reo ka mate te reo Māori. Ki a ia, e wha ngā reinga o te matenga o tētahi reo, arā, te marutanga, te reo ruatanga, te pirautanga, te matenga. Ki ūna whakaaro i tae atu te reo Māori ki te reo ruatanga e rua whakatipuranga ki muri.

Ko te whakautu o te Iwi Māori hai whakakore i tēnei āhuatanga, te whakatūnga o ngā wānanga pēnei i te kōhangā reo, te kura kaupapa, te wānanga, me te whai pepa hoki i ngā wānanga Pākehā. Engari, ki te whakaaro ake tātau, e

pehea ana te hapai o te reo Māori i wēnei rā, ka pupu ake wētahi pakirehua.
Kai roto o tēnei upoko ka whakautu i wēnei uitanga ;

- 1 Ka mau he reo tuturu e whakamahi ana i ngā āhuatanga katoa o te reo i wēnei wāhi ako?
- 2 Pēhea te kawenga o ngā wānanga i tēnei kaupapa?
- 3 He huarahi anō hai whainga mō te iwi Māori?

“E Kore au e ngaro, he kākano i ruia mai i Rangiatea”⁶³, he kupu whakaharahara wēnei, mai i te wā i whakawhiti mai o tātau tipuna i te Moananui-a-Kiwa kua rangona tēnei whakatauki. Engari, i wēnei rā, ka pehea te oranga o te reo Māori (tētahi o aua kakano). Kua tae ki te wā, kai te kiia, ka ora tonu te reo Māori? Ka mutu, ka ora tonu te reo Māori tūturu?

Tuatahi, ko te reo Māori tūturu, te reo e kore e ngaro. He tokā tū moana i roto i ngā wai karekare o te aohurihuri. Ahakoa te aha, kai reira tonu e pūmau ana. Tuarua, ko te reo Māori tūturu i heke iho mai i ngā tipuna, tōna wairua, tōna mauri hoki. Te reo i waenganui i te whānau, te reo i kōrerohia e ngā mātua ki ō rātau tamariki.

Ko te reo tūturu he reo tuku iho mai i ngā tipuna. I o rātau taenga mai ka whakaparekereketia te reo i haria mai ai i Hawaiki, ki te oneone o Aotearoa, i tanumia ai. Mai i te kohuretanga ake i roto i te oneone nei i whakatipuria ai, poipoia ai, i penapenatia ai, i manaakitia ai, i tipu ai, ā, nō te tipunga ka haumi, ka āwhiowhio tōna kakara ki ngā tōpito o tō rātau āo o neherā. He pono, he tika, he rerekētanga anō o te reo e puritia ana e tēnā iwi, e tēnā iwi engari ko te mea nui e mōhio ana rātau ki ngā rerekētanga nei. E taea ana e rātau te kōrero

tētahi ki tētahi, puta atu i Aotearoa katoa⁶⁴. Ko te mauri o tērā reo, ko te wairua o tērā reo nā ngā whānau, nā ngā hapū i pupuri. Ko te mita nā ngā whānau i whakatakoto, engari, ko ngā reo Māori katoa nā ngā whakaaro Māori i hapai. Kia puta ai te wairua Māori i te kōrero. Ko te tangi o te reo Māori nā te taiao i hapai.

Ka rere te pakirehua, “kai te haere te reo ki hea i wēnei rā?” I te mea, he ao hou tēnei, kai te ngaro haere ngā kaikorero Māori, kai te noho hangū te reo Māori ki wētahi marae. Kai te kī mai wētahi tangata, mā ngā wānanga anake e mau ai te reo Māori.

Engari e ai ki wētahi ki te kore e kōrerongia te reo i te kainga ka mate noa. Ki ngā whakaaro a Timoti Karetu⁶⁵, ko te kainga te wāhi hirahira mō te hekenga iho o tētahi reo mai i tētahi whakatipuranga ki tētahi whakatipuranga, kā akona ngā tamariki i te reo o ū rātau kaitiaki, mama rānei. Engari pehea te hunga mātua kore reo Māori? Koinei te wāhi ki ngā wānanga.

Ko ngā mahi a ngā wānanga, ko te ako i te reo, engari kai te marae, te kainga rānei te tūturutanga o te reo. Ka takotoria he huarahi e ngā wānanga kia takahi atu ngā akonga ki ngā pinakitanga o te reo. Engari kia eke tangaroa te tangata ki ngā taumata o te reo me hoki ki tōna ukaipo ki tōna iwi rānei, hai reira kimi ai i tōna ake reo tūturu. Kai tōna kainga tūturu ngā waiata koroua, ngā whakatauāki, ngā pepeha, ngā whakanikoniko o tōna reo tūturu. Kai reira ngā kete wānanga i waihotia e Tane.

Engari, kua rōa te noho o te reo Māori i waenganui i te reo Pākehā, kua uru mai ngā kupu Pākehā ki roto i te reo Māori, ā, kua noho tangata whenua i te

reo. Kai te āwangawanga te iwi kai te puta he reo hou, ehara i te reo Māori tūturu.

Ehara i te mea hou te āmiomio haere o tētahi reo. Ko ngā reo katoa o te ao ka huri, tai timu, tai pari, karekau he reo e mau pono ana ki tētahi āhuatanga, a, noho pēnā mō ake tonu atu. Inā, ka tirohia e tātau wētahi atu reo o te ao kai reira ngā tauira. Pērā i te reo Rātini. I pūmau tēnei reo i roto i te Hāhi Katorika, he tū whare wānanga o ngā tau ki muri. Engari tae mai ki wēnei wā kua mate haere te reo Rātini tūturu. Engari ka ora tonu te reo Rātini i ūna mokopuna, arā, te reo Wīwī, te reo Pāniora me te reo Itāria. He tohu tēnei, ka huri te āhua o ngā reo.

Nō reira ka huri te āhua o ngā reo katoa i runga i ngā āhuatanga o te wā. Tērā pea kaore e taea te pūmau ki tētahi reo tūturu engari hai tērā rau tau ka rerekē te reo pēnei tonu nei i te reo Māori tūturu o tēnei wa. He rerekē ki te reo i ruia mai i Rangiatea. He rerekē mai i te reo o ngā rau tau ki muri. Ko tētahi mahi nui ko te whakaputa i ngā kupu hou hai awhina i ngā tamariki ki te whakaahua i tō rātou nā ao ake. Ki te kore e taea e rātou te whakaahua o rātou ao mā te reo Māori, ka tahuri rātou ki te reo o Tauiwī, kōrero ai. Ko te reo Pākehā, e pai noa ana tōna oranga, kaha tonu, i te mea, ka kapokapo noa iho i ngā kupu o tēnā o tēnā reo, nā wai rā, nā wai rā ka noho tūturu i roto i tērā reo. Engari ia, ka mau tōnu ko te wairua o te reo Pākehā. Te mea hoki, kia eke te reo me whai i ngā tauira pukenga ka puta mai i te rangahau nei, pēnei i te kū o te kupu.

Pēhea te kawenga o ngā wānanga i tēnei kaupapa? I kōrero i mua rā te kaituhi mō ūna whakaaro o te mahi a ngā wānanga arā te whakatakoto huarahi. Mai i te wā i whakatū ngā wānanga, he nui te neke whakamua o te hunga kōrero Māori. Heoi, pēhea te reo o roto i ngā wānanga?

Ko te raru o ngā wānanga mehemea e pai ana te mahi whakaako me te reo o ngā kaiako he haurahi tēnā kia pai ai te reo o ngā akonga engari i wēnei wā kai te raru ngā kura ki te kimi i ngā kaiako mōhio tūturu rawa atu ki te reo. Te mutunga iho, ki te kore e pai te reo o te kaiako ka puta he reo pōhēhē o ngā akonga. Tae atu, ki te kōrero Māori ngā tamariki ki o rātau koroua te aro i ngā kaumataua. Waihoki, te aro i ngā tamariki i ngā kōrero Māori ā ō rātau koroua.

Ko te tino whakatauteute nōku, kai te tirotiro noa iho ngā wānanga ki te hangaitanga o te reo, kua wareware te taha ki te tangi o te reo, arā, ki te kū o te kupu.

Ka kī ake wētahi ko te reo e whakamahia ana i roto i ngā wānanga ehara i te reo tūturu nō reira he aha te reo kai roto i ngā wānanga? Ko te raru o wētahi o ngā kura kaupapa Māori, kai te kōrero i tētahi reo Māori, engari ko te mauri, te wairua, nō Tauiwi kē. Ko ngā whakaaro e hapaitia ana te reo nō Tauiwi. Ko te reo o wēnei, he mea tūturu, he mea kawe whakaaro Pākehā noa iho rānei? Arā noa atu ngā rerenga kōrero hai tauira i tēnei āhuatanga, arā ‘pea ka haere’ (*perhaps we'll go*), ‘kai te huri tekau’ (*I'm turning ten*), ‘kai te’ (*I am*).

He aha te painga, menā ka kōrero te reo Māori engari ko te wairua o muri he wairua Pākehā, ngā mahi, he mahi Pākehā he tangi/rongo Pākehā hoki. Tērā, ko te reo Māori tūturu, he whakaaro Māori tuatahi, katahi ka kōrero Māori.

Ānei te ui whakamutunga, “he huarahi anō hai whainga mō te Iwi Māori?” Koinei te pātai, karekau he whakautu kotahi, mehēmea ka mōhio ahau ki te whakautu tika, anō nei he atua ahau. Heoi ano, arā anō ngā kupu

whakahirahira, ngā kupu pounamu o Te Rangihau, "ko te rongoa kai roto i ō tātau ringa"⁶⁶.

Nā reira, mā tātau anō te Iwi Māori e pupuri ki tō tātau reo rangatira. Ko tōku marau, mā te kōrero tonu ka ora te reo Māori tūturu, mā ngā whānau, ngā hapū e mau ai te reo tūturu. Ki te kore e kōrero te reo tūturu i waenga i te whānau me ngā wānanga kaore e eke ngā uri whakatipu ki ngā taumata o te reo.

Kua puta ngā kaupapa pēnei i te kohanga reo, kura kaupapa me ngā whare wānanga Māori. Engari kai te raru ngā tangata i te mea he rerekē te reo -a-waha ki te reo-a-tuhi. Kaore i te tino pai te whakawhiti o te reo Māori, he reo a waha ki te reta whakaata. Ko te whakaaro o ngā tāngata pēnei i Te Kooti Rikirangi, whakarerea te reta whakaata, puritia te reo-a -waha, kua pēnei hoki wētahi atu o ngā Poropiti Māori.

Kua whakatū te Taura Whiri i te Reo Māori, ko ā rātau mahi te hapai i te reo Māori. He maha ngā āhuatanga o tēnei mahi. Ko tētahi te whakahanga i ngā kupu hou. Ko te tūmanako ka aro rātau ki tēnei mahi me te whakaaro hoki, kaua e whai i te whakamārama noa iho o te kupu Pākehā engari whaia te tauira o ū tātau mātua tīpuna arā, te rongo atu ki te tangi o te mea e tapaina ingoa, ā, hai reira he huarahi hai tapa ingoa. Kua kōrerohia mō ngā ingoa pēnā i ngā tāngata Wiwi. Koiraka tētahi tauira.

I tēnei upoko, kua kōrerohia ngā āhuatanga o te reo, i ahu mai i hea, pēhea te hapaitanga ināianei, ā, kai te haere ki hea te reo. Kua kitea ngā whakanikonikotanga o te reo hoki.

TE UPOKO TUAWHA

KO NGĀ URI O KŪ

I te upoko tuatoru i kōrerohia te āhua e pā ana ki te reo Māori, nā reira ka tau iho ki tēnei upoko ko te mahi kē he tirotiro ki ngā tūmomo kū o te kupu arā, ngā uri o Kū. Mā ngā mahi o tēnei upoko ka ngāwari ake ai te āta tirotiro ki ngā waiata, ki ngā karakia o te upoko tuaono.


Ko te kū o te kupu, he hononga i te oro me te whakamārama o te kupu. Inā hoki i roto i te reo o te tangata hai reira ngā taha e tino hono ai te oro me te whakamārama, pēnei nā hoki i ngā whakaputanga ohorere o te tangi, o te mamae, otirā te tokopuaha. I roto i wēnei tauira te mea noa ake a te oro me tōna whakamārama hai whakaata i te ngākau, i te tinana, i te hinengaro hoki.

Kua rangahaua kē e te Pākehā te āhuatanga o te kū o te kupu. Nō reira i te tīmatatanga i whai ahau i ngā tauira Pākehā. Engari kua whakaurua he wairua Māori ki roto i wētahi, ā, ka whakamāori i wētahi, ka mutu, kua hanga tauira hou mō te reo Māori i wētahi wā.

Ahakoa ko tā te Pākehā mahi he wetewete i ngā āhuatanga i ū rātau reo, ehara i te mea hou te kū o te kupu ki te reo Māori, me kii, he mea kua takoto huna. Ko tāku nā mahi, i tēnei wā, he whakaatu ake i tēnei āhuatanga. Nō reira ka tīmata ake ki te whakapapa i ngā uri o Kū.

Tēnā, me ka whakapapahia mai te kupu orōmahara (oro o mahara) ānei ūnauri whakaheke. Inā kai roto i te whika 3 ka kite iho ki te moe a Kū rāua ko Pū ka puta ko te uri Kupu. Ka moe a Kupu i a Oro, ka puta ko Kupu Oro. Ka moe a Kupu Oro i a mahara ka puta ki waho ko Kupu orōmahara (*ideophone*) . I mua

i te whātorohanga atu ki roto i te puku o tēnei upoko me āta whakamārama, ki te hohonutanga, whānuitanga ki tēnei, ki te kupu ‘*ideophone*’ kua tapaina nei e ahau ki te ingoa ‘kupu orōmahara’. Ānei rā ngā wāhangā e toru o te kupu orōmahara, tuatahi ko te oro, tuarua ko te puāwai, tuatoru ka mutu ake ai ko mahara. Ka tōpūria wēnei wāhangā e toru, e kore e wehewehetia kia hāngai ki te kupu nei kupu orōmahara. Ko te puāwai, ko ia te takawaenga o te oro me te mahara. Mā te rongo o te oro ka puāwai te mahara.

Ka moe a Kupu orōmahara i a Rongo, ka puta ko ngā uri tokotoru nei, arā, ko ngā āhuatanga o te kōrerorero, ko te waiata me ō rāua āronga, tikanga hoki. Ka whakaingoahia ake, tuatahi ko Kupu Tā Ahua (*gesture*). Tuarua, ko Kupu Ororite (*onomatopes*), tuatoru, ko Kupu Hanga Pā (*kinaesthesia*). Ka moe hoki a Kupu orōmahara i a Kite, ka puta ko Kupu Hao Tangi (*synesthesia*).

Ka tīmata ake ki te whakamārama ake i te kupu hao tangi. I te mea kua moe a Kite i a Kupu orōmahara, he āhuatanga te kupu hao tangi e whakaatu atu i tētahi nekeneketanga/āhuatanga e kore e taea te rongo-a-taringa engari mā te karu kē e kite.. Āna, ko ngā nekeneketanga e meahia nei te nuinga he tino kaha te tāmaramara, inā ko te hikoi, te piu, te tumatumā, te totitoti me te wiriwiri. E kore te tangata e rongo-a-taringa ki te tāmaramara engari mā te karu kē e kite. Inā anō wētahi, ko te pīataata, ko te tīramarama, arā, ka tīramarama he whetū; i

te rongona atu ki te kupu nei ka toko ake i te hinengaro he mea e pīatatata mai ana. Nō reira, mā te rongo atu ki tētahi kupu ka tau ki roto i te hinengaro o te tangata te āhuatanga o tērā nekenekehanga, āhuatanga rānei.

Ki te hinengaro Māori he āhuatanga anō te kite mai i te rongo, nō reira kua wehewehea ngā mea e rua. Kia hoki ki te whakapapa o Kū, nā te moetanga o Rongo ka puta ko ngā uri tokotoru nei. Kātahi ko kupu tā āhua, ko te kupu e pupu ake i ngā mea o te *gesture*, arā, ōrite te mahi o te ārero, o te waha rānei, ki te whakamārama o te kupu. Hai tauira ake, ko te kupu kapokapo, kua rite te mahi o te waha ki te mahi kapokapo. Tērā hoki te kanikani, ka kanikani te arero i te waha hoki.

Ka rua ko te kupu hanga pā, ko te whakaaturanga o te mahi o te tinana, o te ngākau. Mā te rongo ki tētahi kupu hanga pā, ka pupū ake he kare a roto (*feelings/ emotion states*) i te kaiwhakarongo. Nā reira kāore te tangata e rongo-a-taringa engari ka rongo a ngākau kē. Ka toru ko te kupu ororite. Koinei te kupu orōmahara e tino whakamahi ana e te Māori. Ka wehewehea tēnei kupu hai āta whakamāramahia.


Te Kupu ororite

Ko te kupu ororite he kupu whakaata i ngā oro noa o te ao, arā, ko ngā oro pēnei i te pakē, pakō, rārā, hihī te whio me wērā atu. Ka pā rawa ki wērā momo whakaahua, arā ngā oro o te taiao (arā, patopato, haruru, ngunguru).

Nō reira, ka uru mai ngā tangi o ngā manu me wērā tangi ā ngā kīrehe, me wērā ngā tangitangi a ngā tamariki, me ngā wēwē o ngā motokā pirihimana.

Hāunga anō rā hoki te mahi ā te reo, ki te whakaari nekenekē tairite ki ngā kōrero o te kū o te kupu. Heoti, i ngā kori nekenekēhangā, he oro anō hoki tāna mahi. Engari i tua atu i tērā ko te hotuhotu o te tangi me te tāmaramara o te kori, tino pātata ki te āhua o te whakaaro o te tangata. Tata tonu te kore e taea te whakawehewehe i a rāua. Ka kitea tēnei tūmomo āhuatanga i te tangata e korikori ana, ka tangi kau he waiata he whakatangitangi rānei. Arā rā ka pakipaki ngā ringaringa, ka patōpatō ngā matimati o te waewae, ka kori te tinana ki te kanikani, koinei ngā ahutanga a tēnei hanga kupu. Na te mea ka taea e te tangata te whakamāori i te tangi a kori, ki te kori a tinana, ka taea anō e rātau te takahuri te kori a tinana ki te kori a tangi, hui atu anō hoki ki ngā āhuatanga o te kū o te kupu. I roto rā i te whakapuakitanga o ngā tangi me ngā neke hai konei ka whakamahia e te hunga hanga reo te whakahuarua o ngā kupu ana ka kī he whakarite i te kori e whakaaria mai ana.

Ahakoa anō ka taea te tohe i wēnei kupuranga korikori he āhua momo kupu hao-tangi nō te me he kaha pātata ki ngā ororitetanga ka meahia wēnei ki te kupu whakamārama nei arā ki te ororitetanga nekenekē ka whakauruhia ai ki tēnei ranga kōrero. Kua hangaia e Baldon⁶⁸ tētahi whakapapa o te kupu ororite, nā, kai roto i te whika 4 e whakaatu ana.

Te Kupu oro whakaata

Ko tēnei kupu te oro whakaata hai whakaahua i te mea e kōrerohia ana e te tangata. Otirā he kupu ororite tēnei hai whakaata i te mea e rongohia e te tangata mō tētahi mea e kōrerohia ana e ia. Hai tauira ake arā te oro o te kēti waikura. Kekē kau ana ngā kūhā o te kēti waikura i te wā e kūwherawhia ana i te tangata mahi pāmu. Inā anō tētahi, noke neke nukunuku haere. Ka taea hoki te whakahua roa i te pū o te kupu hei whakaata i tā te kai kōrero e hiahia ana arā, “he ika tiiino nuuui rawa atu”.

Te Kupu nā tangata

Koinei te whakamahinga o wētahi oro hamumu hai tohu i roto i te ngākau, tinana rānei o te kaikōrero. Kai roto i tēnei wāhanga kupu, ko ngā oro ohorere (*involuntary*) whakaatu atu pēnei i te mare, i te kane, i te tokopuake rānei, ahu pērā atu hoki ki te haku me te mapu o te reo. Ka taea hoki te tautohe ehara wēnei i te tino kū o te kupu nā te mea, ehara hoki i te tino kupu, he tohu, he whakaata kē. - 6) Ngā whakahua o te arotakenga me ngā puanga whakahoahoa a te kaikōrero ki te hunga e anga mai ai ki ngā kōrero

I roto i te upoko 4 nei i whakaatuhiā mai ngā momo kū, arā, ngā uri o Kū me ū rātau whakamārama me te whakapapa o wēnei uri.

Kai roto i te upoko e whai ake nei, ka whāia ake wētahi tauira kia aromatawaia wētahi tauira o te kū o te kupu e takoto ana ki rō waiata, ki rō karakia hoki.





Whika 5: Te reti o te oro ki waenganui i ngā hau.







Ka tirohia ngā hua kua puta mai i te rangahau nei me tētahi whakataunaki. Ka whakaaro ake ki ngā huarahi hai whai atu a muri ake i te rangahau nei.

Ka tīmata ake tēnei upoko ki te waiata Te Aumangea, “he waiata tangi tēnei mō ngā kaikōrero whai mana o te ao Māori, arā, a Tā Kingi, a Mōnita Delamere, a Māori Marsden, a Pumi Taituha, a Hamu Mitchell, a Hōhua Tūtengāehe, a wai ake, a wai ake”¹⁰³. Ko te take i whiriwhiri ai i tēnei waiata nā te mea i mōhio nei wēnei tangata ki te rāwekeweke, ki te huri, ki te whiu, ki te whakatakoto i te kupu, kua kore haere i kitea tērā momo i roto i te ao Māori o wēnei rā. I roto anō hoki i te haku, ko te tūmanako ka aro mai ngā tangata kia tū mai anō taua rite i roto i wēnei reanga e kaha nei te whai mai.

Ko te waiata-ā-ringa tēnei i toa i ngā whakataetae nui o te motu i tū nei ki Hāwera i te tau 1994, ā, ko te kapa nāna i kawe ko Tū-te-maunga-roa o te rohe o Te Whanga-nui-a-Tara. 



APITIHANGA II

Acoustic expression of emotional states. According to Friederich Marpurg

Emotion	Expression
Sorrow	Slow, languid melody; sighing; caressing of single words with exquisite tonal material; prevailing dissonant harmony
Happiness	Fast movement; animated and triumphant melody; warm tone colour; more consonant harmony
Contentment	A more steady and tranquil melody than with happiness
Repentance	The elements of sorrow, except that a turbulent, lamenting melody is used
Hopefulness	A proud and exultant melody
Fear	Tumbling downward progressions, mainly in the lower register
Laughter	Drawn out, languid tones
Fickleness	Alternating expressions of fear and hope
Timidity	Similar to fear, but often intensified by an expression of impatience
Love	Consonant harmony; soft, flattering melody in broad movements
Hate	Rough harmony and melody
Envy	Growling and annoying tones
Compassion	Soft, smooth, lamenting melody; slow movement; repeated figures in the bass
Jealousy	Introduced by a soft, wavering tone; then an intense, scolding tone; finally a moving and sighing tone; alternating slow and quick movement
Wrath	Expression of hate combined with running notes; frequent sudden changes in the bass; sharp violent movements; shrieking dissonances
Modesty	Wavering, hesitating melody; short, quick stops
Daring	Defiant, rushing melody
Innocence	A pastoral style
Impatience	Rapidly changing, annoying modulations
