

Naming of photomicrographs

The first number corresponds to the field sample number (sample log can be found in Appendix A-1.2 inside the thesis). Samples that were not used in the initial thesis are not recorded on this log, but can be found in the 'other sample numbers log' excel file on this DVD. The letter in front of this number can be ignored as it is for my records. The following 'x' symbol and number represents the magnification on the microscope that was being used at the time the photo was taken. 9 is the frame size used when scaling the photos. The remaining numbers are not important.

Please note there is a scalebar for each magnification used, the entire bar is 2 mm long. These are different for the cathodoluminescent (CL) and plane polarised light (PPL) photomicrographs.
