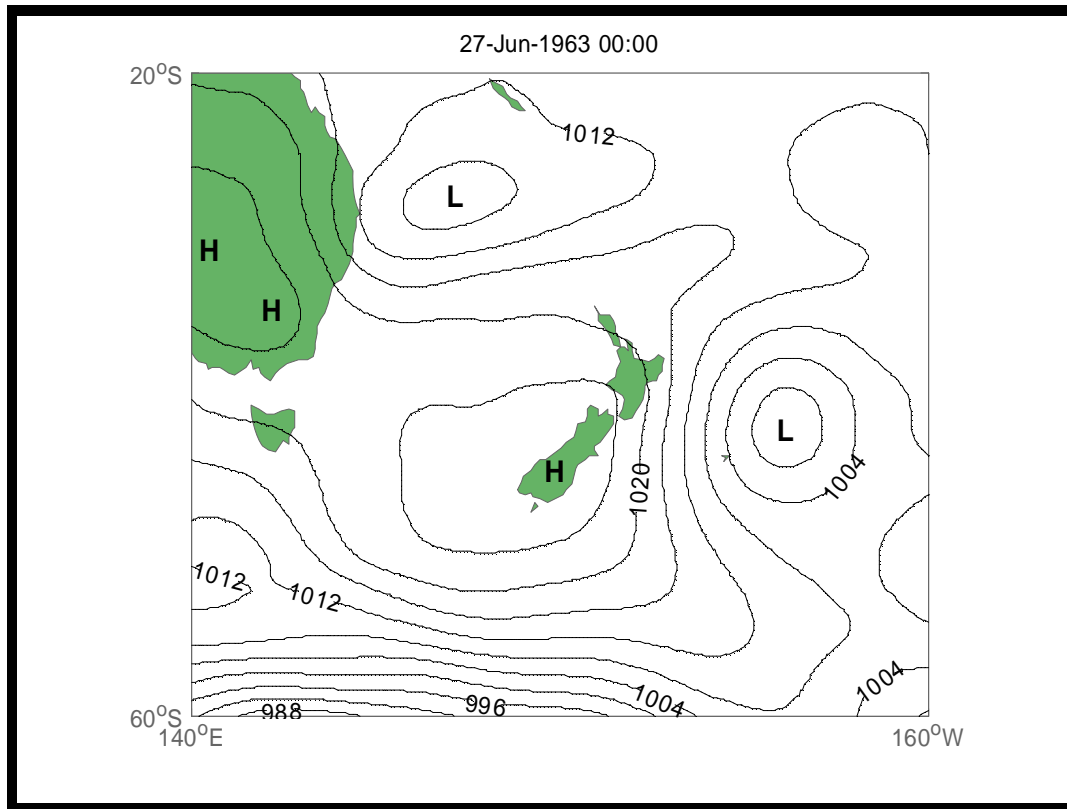


Coastal Storm Database - Event Summary

Synoptic Conditions

A trough from the southern ocean extended northward over NZ and developed into a closed centre just east of Chatham Islands. At the same time an intense anticyclone had moved onto the South Island. Between these systems a southerly airstream was created and swept over the eastern North Island.
